Reader Paul Smith (14) tells us about his interesting hobby

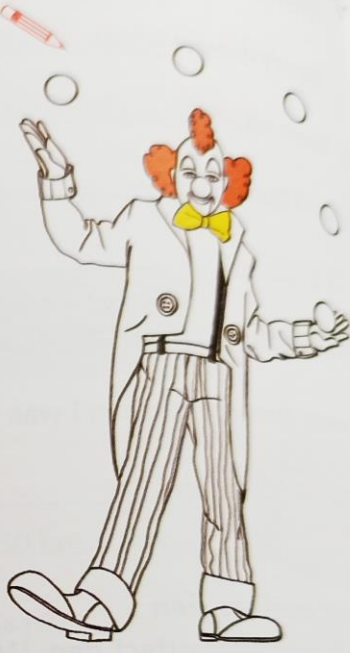
Clowning about
